

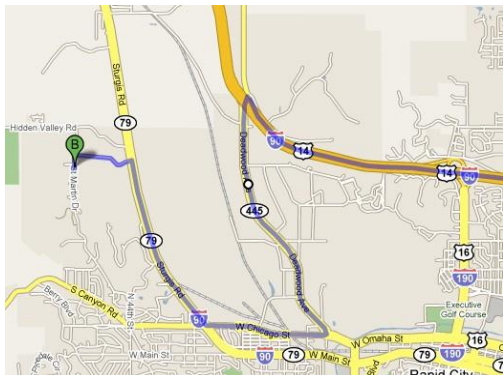
Driving Directions

From the East



From I-90 Westbound

Take exit **55** for **Deadwood Avenue**

Turn left onto Deadwood Avenue – continue for 2.2 miles

Turn Right at W Chicago St – continue for 1.1 miles

Turn Right onto Sturgis Road/SD-79

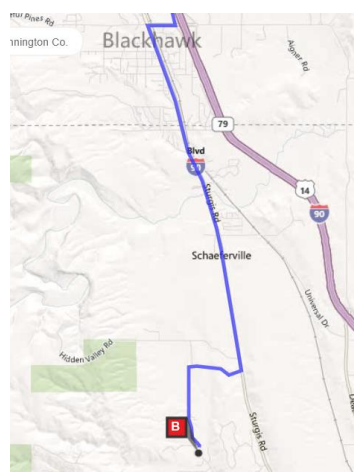
From Sturgis Rd (SD 79)

Look for a large tan/stone (photo right) on the west side of SD-79 (Sturgis Road) indicating the turn to Terra Sancta, St. Martin Monastery, etc.

- From the EAST - Turn **left** onto **St Martin Drive ...**
- From the WEST - Turn **right** onto **St Martin Drive...**

Follow St Martin Drive up the hill and to the right. At the bottom of the hill, the road curves to the left and becomes City Springs Rd. The Terra Sancta campus and buildings are on the right side of the road – facing east. The main entrance for the retreat center faces west - so drive past the large parking lot for St Elizabeth Seton School, then past the parking lot for Holy Cross Chapel and take a right (at the sign on the right) and drive around the building to get to our main entrance (photo below right). Additional information about parking areas is on the reverse.

From the West



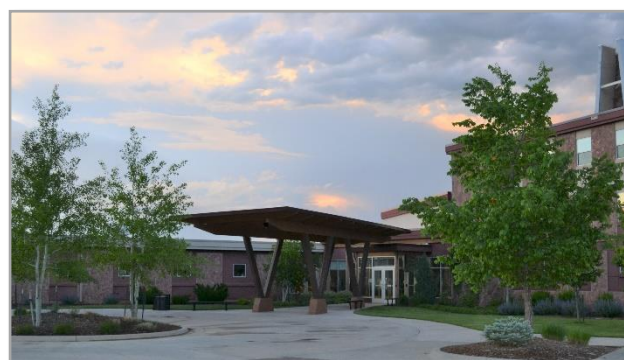
From I-90 Eastbound

At exit **52** take ramp **right** for **Peaceful Pines Rd** toward **Black Hawk**

Turn **right** onto **Peaceful Pines Rd**

Turn **left** at stoplight onto **I-90 Blvd East/ Sturgis Rd/SD-79**

Continue to follow SD-79 (Sturgis Rd) for 3.4 miles.
